Every Scout deserves a trained leader!

Through training, you'll get the tools you need to run a safe, fun, and successful Cub Scouting program.

What's Required

All registered adult leaders must take Youth Protection Training (YPT) online and renew it every year.

To be considered trained for your position, and entitled to wear the "Trained" patch, you must take **Position-Specific Training** for your role (Den Leader, Cubmaster, Committee Member, etc.). You can do it online or in person (see below). Also, if your pack goes camping, at least one leader on the trip must be **BALOO**-trained. Online training is available at <http://my.scouting.org>.

In-Person Course Descriptions

Position-Specific Training: Learn about your role; pick up new skills, program ideas, activities, and resources; and share tips with other leaders. We run 1.5- to 2-hour courses for Den Leaders, Cubmasters/Assistants, and Pack Committee, as well as a 4-hour combined course.

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO): A one-day intro to the skills needed to plan and run Cub Scout outdoor activities—and the rules that help keep them safe. Learn about the fun you can have outdoors!

Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills (OWL): An overnight course geared toward Webelos outdoor activities. You'll get hands-on practice in camping skills, fire-building, outdoor cooking, knots, woods tools, outdoor-focused activity badges, program planning, and more.
