

## Responsibilities of a UNIT TRAINING COORDINATOR:

- Help adults in your pack, troop, or crew get the training they need.
- Spread the word about online training and upcoming live courses.
- Keep track of who has been trained.
- Help make sure your leaders get recognized for being trained (“Trained” patch, training knots).
- Serve as a direct link with the district training chairs.

For Cub packs, this position is already recognized as “Pack Trainer.” For troops and crews, there’s no official patch for this position, but it’s no less important. (If you really want a patch, we’ll make one...)
